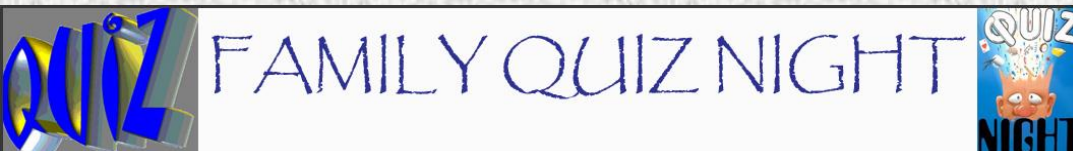

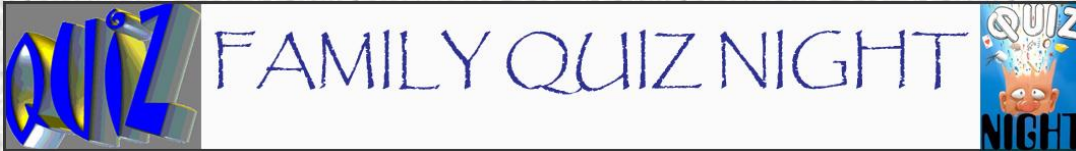

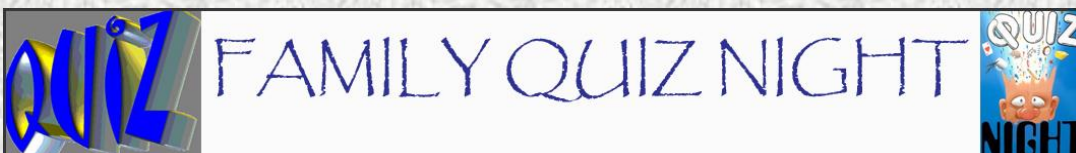

*The 2012 family camp was held over a very pleasant early autumn weekend from Friday 14<sup>th</sup> to Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> September at Sherbrooke Scout Camp, Calverton. The camp which is open to all 3<sup>rd</sup> Woodthorpe scout age groups and their family members was attended by around 40 people.*

*Upon arrival Tents were quickly pitched with the focus of Friday night being the evening Barbeque, social round the camp fire and informal play amongst the scouts.*

*Blue skies and sunshine welcomed the camp on Saturday morning and following a cooked breakfast the main event of the morning was archery with the scouts demonstrating their skills in the bulls-eye shoot out competition and beating their parents.*

*Following informal play and lunch the afternoon saw a walk which required map reading skills to navigate a route around some very pleasant footpaths surrounding the scout camp. The walk incorporated a challenge to identify various plants, animals, birds and insects. A welcome distraction on the route was the Bridge Inn at Oxton, not officially part of the route, but very well frequented by 3W members and only left a short distance back to base camp.
